

# 20 Twenty's Plenty in Lambeth 20

## Did you know;

- lowering urban and residential speed limits to 20 mph has been found to decrease child pedestrian accidents by 70%?
- speed limits on Britain's urban roads are 60% higher than in Europe?
- Britain has the highest percentage of pedestrian road fatalities in Europe - and that this is increasing?
- more than half of road deaths and serious injuries occur on roads with 30 mph limits?
- 29% of Lambeth school children would prefer to cycle to school - but only 3% actually do?
- British parents consistently cite traffic speed as the main reason why their children are not allowed to cycle or walk to school?

## What do we want?

A 20 mph default speed limit on all residential roads in Lambeth.

## How can we get that?

By getting all Lambeth's political parties to sign up to the 20's Plenty campaign before the local elections on May 6th.
